



University of Chicago 2009 Provost's Summer Fellowship

AWARD

The University of Chicago Provost's Summer Fellowship will provide a limited number of summer fellowships for Summer 2009. The Fellowship provides \$3,000 to doctoral students who matriculated prior to Spring 2007, who meet the eligibility criteria below, and who wish to engage in academic-related activities during the Summer Quarter. The fellowship can be used for—but is not limited to—the following purposes:

- Exam preparation
- Proposal preparation
- Dissertation research or write-up
- Collaborative project with faculty
- Language study at the U of C or another domestic or foreign institution

ELIGIBILITY

- **Humanities, Social Sciences, and Divinity School** applicants must be enrolled full-time and have entered with the **2005 or 2006 Cohorts**
- Both **U.S. citizens and international students** are eligible.
- At the end of the summer, recipients must **submit a summary** of Provost's Summer Fellowship activities to their Dean of Students.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Students must submit the following application materials to their Dean of Students by **April 30** (see contact information below):

1. **Provost's Summer Fellowship Application Form** (attached).
2. **Statement of Purpose** of no more than 500 words describing proposed use of Provost's Summer Fellowship funds.
3. **Letter of support** from a faculty member who is familiar with the applicant's work and who endorses the proposed use of Fellowship funds.

SELECTION PROCESS

Highest priority will go to students with the greatest need who have not previously won a Provost's Summer Fellowship. Awards will be allocated among academic units according to the unit size number of applicants.
