Please visit the new graduate student website at <http://welcome.uchicago.edu/graduate.html> and follow the instructions regarding claiming your cNetID. You will need your cNetID will establish your email account, maintain your personal information and access secure university websites. To claim the cNetID, you may need to know your University of Chicago identification number (UCID): XXXXXX.

All University of Chicago students are expected to maintain and check uchicago email addresses. If you do not plan to use that email address, please set it up to automatically forward to your preferred email address, as all university correspondence will come to your uchicago email address. You do not need to inform the admissions office of your new uchicago email address unless you would prefer to have these New Student emails sent to your new email address. Starting now, you are also expected to keep your contact information up-to-date at: <https://cmore.uchicago.edu>. We receive updates from cmore, so as long as you update your address and phone number there, you will no longer need to update the Admissions office or the Dean of Students office about address or phone changes. Most other university systems will also receive these updates automatically. Your department will let you know if you should continue to send updates to them.

For those of you who already have a cNetID, your account should remain active, or be reactivated. Please let me know if you encounter any problems with this. Also please remember to visit <https://cmore.uchicago.edu> to keep your contact information up-to-date, so that your registration is not restricted.
