BA THESIS PROPOSAL FORM

Students who wish to be considered for honors must apply to the Director of Undergraduate Studies before the end of their third year (ideally by the fifth week of the Spring Quarter). Eligible candidates must have a GPA of 3.6 or higher in course in the major and typically a minimum GPA of 3.25 overall. To receive honors, students must develop an extended piece of research via a bachelor's essay under the approved supervision of a regular faculty member in the Anthropology Department. BA projects involving alternative media (e.g., a film, photo-essay, or art installation) may be acceptable if accompanied by written text, but contingent upon the approval of the student's advisor and the Director of Undergraduate Studies.

Students writing BA theses are strongly urged to enroll in ANTH 29910 BA Honors Seminar I in Autumn Quarter to learn research design and how to organize data and/or to enroll in ANTH 29920 BA Honors Seminar II in Winter Quarter to write a complete draft. Students may also arrange to work one-on-one with a faculty advisor on their thesis and register for credit under ANTH29900 Preparation of Bachelor's Essay.
