

APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL AID SOCIAL SCIENCES FELLOWSHIP **SUMMER GRANT 2017**

Doctoral students who have a summer grant as part of their Social Sciences fellowship and who wish to use the grant for Summer 2017 must complete this application form and return it to their Department by May 1, 2017, for approval, unless the Department has a standard guideline for disbursing the summer grant. If your Department/Program has a standard guideline, you do not need to submit this application the summer grant will be disbursed according to the guideline, contingent on renewal of your fellowship following the spring performance review. If your Department/Program has a standard guideline, and you wish to use the summer grant outside the guideline, you must submit this application to request an exception.

Summer grants, as well as the academic year fellowship, are contingent on good progress. Students should make arrangements to remove any incompletes from their transcripts. First-year students in particular should note that quality grades (not P or R) are expected. At minimum, five of the quality grades from Autumn and Winter Quarters must be posted in advance of the spring divisional performance review for the summer grant to be disbursed.

Students are expected to use the grant in support of an academic engagement over the summer, but formal summer registration is not required.
